

Call for speakers for the 2 incoming meetings in China

I. **Third CAPA-Beijing Pathology Symposium**

Beijing, 9/2/2017-9/3/2017

The third CAPA-Beijing Pathology Symposium will be held jointly by CAPA and the Chinese Academy of Medicine Cancer Hospital and Institute in Beijing, September 2-3, 2017.

In this year, the meeting will have a case based discussion focusing on the emerging concepts, new markers, new classification or challenging diagnosis.

Up to eight qualified speakers are needed for this meeting. The criteria for the speakers as below:

1. Attending physician (prefer associate professor and above; experienced assistant professor also welcome) in academic institutions
2. A regular or life time member of CAPA
3. If multiple people apply: preference will be given to someone with teaching experiences in China and speakers not from the same institution.

The content and format of the lecture:

1. Length of the lecture: 30-60 minutes depend on how many people will go
2. Format of the lecture: case based
3. Content: anatomic pathology related (including lymphoma, autopsy and AP molecular pathology)

The deadline for submission is **June 9, 2017**. The final selection of the speakers will be reviewed and made by the CAPA Education Committee/contents subcommittee and approved by Executive Committee.

Costs:

1. The international travel will not be covered.
2. The registration, local transportation and lodging during the meeting will be covered.
3. Honorarium: not set by the organizers at this moment depend on the financial support. If yes, minimum.

II. **The Chinese Society of Pathology (CSP) Annual Meeting**

Suzhou, Jiangsu Province, 10/26/2017-10/29/2017

CAPA will have a separated session (The exact time TBD) during the CSP annual meeting. There is no particular limitation on topics, but the CSP organizers prefer case based lectures focusing on the emerging concepts, new markers, new classification or challenging diagnosis. Other format is also welcome.

Up to eight qualified speakers are needed for this meeting. The criteria for the speakers as below:

1. Associate professor and above in major academic centers (requested by the CSP meeting organizers). Exception on special topics: digital pathology, artificial intelligence, etc.
2. A regular or life time member of CAPA
3. If multiple people apply: the preference will be given to

- a. The person with teaching experiences in China (consulted with CSP meeting organizers) and speakers not from the same institution.
 - b. The person who submit the required documentation earlier
 - c. Incomplete submission will not be considered.
4. The speakers invited by the Chinese subcommittees already do not submit the application here anymore.

The content and format of the lecture:

1. Length of the lecture: 30-60 minutes depend on how many people will go
2. Format of the lecture: case based preferred (other format is also fine)
3. Content: anatomic pathology related (including lymphoma, autopsy and AP molecular pathology)
4. Digital pathology and artificial intelligence will be considered separately

The deadline for submission is **June 16, 2017**. The final selection of the speakers will be reviewed and made by the CAPA Education Committee/Contents subcommittee and approved by Executive Committee.

Costs:

1. The international travel will not be covered
2. The registration, local transportation and lodging during the meeting will be covered.
3. Honorarium: minimum (based on the old experience: 0-1000 RMB, not certain at this time)
