



Call for 2018 CAPA Best Abstract Award for Pathologists-in-Training

On behalf of the Chinese American Pathologists Association (CAPA) Executive Committee, we are delighted to announce the **2018 CAPA Best Abstract Award for Pathologists-in-Training**.

The mission of the Chinese American Pathologists Association is to promote excellence in practice, education and research in pathology, as well as advocacy on behalf of Chinese pathologists. The objective of the CAPA Best Abstract Award is to encourage and reward outstanding research contributions by our young pathologists.

Eligibility:

- 1) First authors in abstracts that have been accepted for either platform or poster presentation at the 2018 USCAP Annual Meeting
- 2) Pathologists-in-training (current residents and fellows) of Chinese ethnicity in North America

Application:

Submit the accepted abstracts along with USCAP acceptance notices to Dr. Charles Guo by emailing to ccguo@mdanderson.org, **no later than December 15, 2018**.

Selection:

The abstracts will be reviewed and scored in a blind fashion by members of the selection committee. Abstracts with the highest average scores will be selected as winners. There will be one winner for the first place, two for the second place, and three for the third place.

Recognition:

The awards will be presented to the winners at the Annual CAPA Business Meeting during the upcoming 2018 USCAP Annual Meeting in the afternoon of Saturday,

March 17, 2018, in Vancouver. Each winner will receive a certificate with his/her name, a cash award, and recognition on the CAPA website. The winners must be present in the CAPA meeting in person; otherwise the awards will be revoked.

The winners will be notified in the beginning of the February 2018, and are required to confirm their attendance to the CAPA meeting.
