Message from the President (2022-2023)

Dear Colleagues of CAPA,

Greetings!

May is the most beautiful and celebratory month of the year. In the U.S., May is the month of graduation. Many commencements are held, millions of pictures taken, hugs given, and best wishes expressed! Young people stormed out with pride and hope. If you have children, relatives and friends graduating this year, please join me by giving them a big round of applause and a virtual toast to celebrate their achievements and resilience in their most precious yet most challenging years due to the COVID pandemic.



May is also a month of sowing, preparing, and working. This is particularly true for our organization, the Chinese American Pathologists Association (CAPA). Shortly after I took office in March, I initiated the process of leadership team building through an open and democratic process. Special thanks to all CAPA members who stepped out to volunteer and serve CAPA. In early April, I nominated executive committee (EC) members and chairs of education, membership and operation, practice and career development, and finance committees/subcommittees. With the diligence and wise work of the CAPA Board of Directors (BOD), all nominations of EC and other committees/subcommittees were approved. In early May, the CAPA 2022 organization chart was formally established. With excellent teamwork from CAPA IT/Website committee led by Dr. Jinming Song, the CAPA official website was updated with the most accurate information mid-May. In addition, an "EDUCATION" tab has been added to host educational materials presented at our various educational programs. Please visit the CAPA website if you have not done so recently.

Excellence through education is a core mission of CAPA. CAPA weekly Online Pathology Course continued without interruption during the transition period. The topics were well picked and the speakers well selected. I am very impressed with the superb quality of lectures in this series. I truly believe this Online Pathology Course serves as the best incubator to allow junior pathologists to refine their teaching skills and prepare them for large stages, both national and international. Organizing an annual diagnostic course has been a tradition for CAPA Presidents. This year will mark the 8th CAPA annual diagnostic course. With inputs from a large

number of CAPA members, a virtual format was decided in April by the leadership team. A meeting organizing group led by Dr. Linsheng Zhang, the Chair of the Education Committee, has been diligently working with chairs of the education committee and subcommittees to develop a complete and high-quality meeting program and to apply for CME credits through the College of American Pathologists (CAP). A full CME application will be submitted by Dr. Zenggang Pan to the College of American Pathologists (CAP) by June 10th, 2022. I am also pleased to announce that Dr. John Hart, the current President of USCAP, will be the keynote speaker at our 8th Annual Diagnostic Course.

Professional betterment is needed to benefit CAPA members. The peer support group (so-called CAPA Leadership, Professionalism, Wellness and Friendship Development (LPWFD) Program) was established last year for this purpose. I am delighted that Dr. Helen Zhang is willing to take over this unique and essential program. I sincerely thank Helen and her team for clearly outlining the activities, initiating the first lecture, and lining up additional excellent speakers for this year. I have no doubt that Helen and her team will deliver a wonderful program touching many aspects of professionalism, leadership, and wellness.

Member recruitment and retention is fundamental for CAPA. Realizing that an increasing number of pathologists of Chinese Descent enter the pathology workforce in North America, we established a subcommittee of pathologists of Chinese Descent this year, and Dr. Jane Hon chairs it. In May, I sent out a letter to invite pathologists and trainees of Chinese heritage to join CAPA. As CAPA members, you have probably received this letter through an email sent out by Dr. Wei Zhang, the Chair of the Membership Committee. Please forward this letter to pathologists and trainees of Chinese heritage in your workplace or department to help CAPA member recruitment.

Collaboration with other medical societies, either pathology or non-pathology, regional, national, and international, reflects our willingness to brand CAPA and to promote CAPA members. As a result, an International Collaboration Committee (ICC) was initiated under the Presidency of Dr. Marilyn Bui last year. With meaningful and constructive discussion and approval from the current BOD, the formation of ICC was completed, and its scope, function, and procedure well defined in May. ICC had its first meeting and several actionable plans panned out regarding several international collaborations. If you have leads on potential international collaborations, please do not hesitate to reach out to the Chairs of ICC, Drs. Huamin Wang and Yun Gong or me.

Financial stability keeps our organization sustainable. We are currently financially stable according to our Treasurer, Dr. Zaibo Li. With the added missions and planned events, we need to continue our fundraising activity and sponsorship solicitation. Dr. Hannah Chen, the Chair of Industry Relations, with her team and Dr. Xiaoxian (Bill) Li, had a brainstorming meeting on how to maintain current industry relations and reach out to entities for additional sponsorship. If you know some companies or individuals who can potentially sponsor CAPA's educational activity, please contact Dr. Hannah Chen or me.

The future of CAPA relies on the continuous infusion of new members who are well mentored and nurtured during their pathology training period. The trainee committee, chaired by Dr. Xin He, has done a fantastic job. Dr. He and his team have already organized several activities for trainees to share their experiences on fellowship application for pathology residents and on how to ace your pathology residency. These events were much appreciated. I believe these activities help attract and prepare future CAPA members.

I have to admit that May is indeed a bustling and energetic month for CAPA and CAPA leadership teams. I sincerely thank you all for trusting me with this great organization. I also would like to thank all BOD members for their guidance and wisdom, all EC members for their strong support and actions, and all volunteers for their generous acts, from hosting meetings to proofreading documents. My dear friends, there are many ways you can volunteer and contribute to CAPA. As established pathologists, you can volunteer your time to give talks

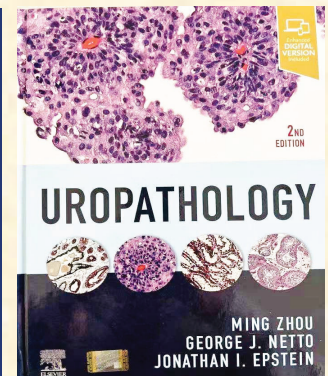
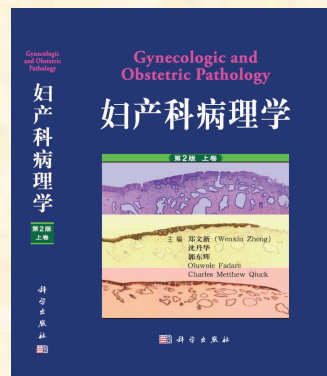

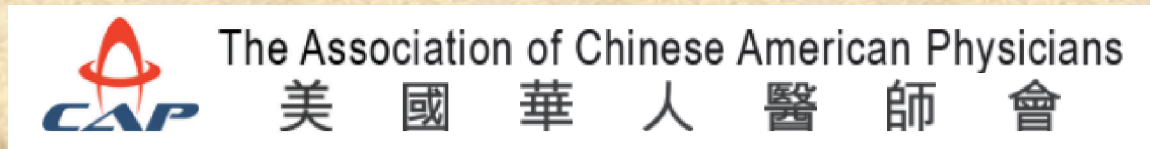
