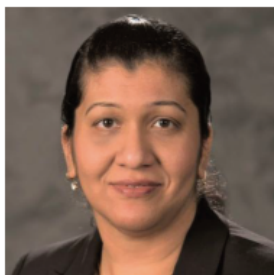

ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Dr. Zhao is a Professor of Gynecological/Breast Pathology & Cytological Director and System Director of Gynecologic Cytology at UPMC. He earned his medical degree from Qingdao Medical College, conducted molecular research at the Hebrew University School of Medicine and UCLA, and completed AP/CP residency at Drexel University. He pursued fellowship training in Gynecologic/Breast Pathology at the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology and Cytopathology at USC.

Since joining Magee-Womens Hospital in 2006, he has become the Full Professor in recognition of his research, which focuses on cervical cancer screening, HPV genotyping, and AI-assisted cervical cytology. He has published over 250 papers and 170 meeting abstracts, delivered 200 invited lectures worldwide, and published or translated numerous pathology books.

As a former member of the CAP Cytopathology Committee, he has led or participated in many national cytology/HPV studies. He also facilitates academic exchange between ASCCP and the Chinese Society of Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology (CSCCP), receiving the ASCCP 2017 Meritorious Service Award for his contributions.
